

# **Appreciation Award Pastoral/Spiritual Care**

## **Introduction**

The PCAGH consistently promotes a high standard of professionalism and service in the field of pastoral/spiritual care throughout Newfoundland and Labrador. In this context there are some persons who go beyond these high standards. The Appreciation Award is a means of acknowledging those who make such contributions. The award will normally be presented annually to a member of the Association who has made a significant contribution to the profession of pastoral/spiritual care.

## **Procedure for Nomination**

- Three members in good standing in the Pastoral Care Allied Health Group must make the nomination in writing.
- The nomination must include biographical information, letters of recommendation and reasons for the nomination.
- The nomination will be forwarded to the Secretary. A sub-committee of the Executive will review the nominations and make a recommendation to the Executive, with the Executive making the final selection.
- Nominations must be received by September 15<sup>th</sup>.

The presentation of the Award will be made at the Annual Pastoral Care Conference and Annual General Meeting and will be awarded as merited.

## **Criteria**

- Member of the PCAHG or by exceptional contribution.
- Significant contribution to the profession of pastoral/spiritual care in the province.
