**The Rt. Rev Donald Phillips,  
Bishop of Rupert's Land Diocese**

Donald Phillips was born, raised and educated in London, Ontario. He graduated with an Honours Bachelor of Science and a Master of Science degree in Inorganic Chemistry from the University of Western Ontario. This was followed by studies at Huron College (UWO) from which he graduated with a Master of Divinity with Honours in 1981. He was ordained deacon and priest in that same year for the Diocese of Athabasca by the Most Reverend Fred Crabb. He served parishes in Athabasca, Lac La Biche and Fort McMurray, Alberta, before moving to St. Michael and All Angels, Moose Jaw, Saskatchewan in the Diocese of Qu'Appelle in 1987. From 1992 to 2000 he served as Ministries Development Coordinator and later Executive Archdeacon. In 2000 he was elected as 12th Bishop of Rupert's Land. A Doctor of Divinity degree was conferred on him in 2002 by Huron College. Donald is married to Nancy, a registered Occupational Health nurse and adult educator. As a couple they were involved from 1990 to 2000 as Clergy Presenters in Anglican Marriage Encounter. They have two adult sons. He has a great love of music, has studied piano, and has sung in choirs and an acappella quartet. He has developed a keen interest in physical fitness over the past 16 years and teaches a step aerobics class at the downtown YMCA in Winnipeg.



**Nancy Phillips, RN, B V/T Ed, COHN(C), Spiritual Director**

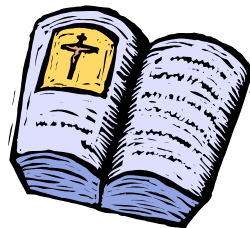
# Happy 30<sup>th</sup> Anniversary PCAHG!

## A bit o' History:

**Chaplain's Section of the Newfoundland Hospital Association (NHA)** had its inception in Corner Brook in **1981**. Dr. Harry Watts promoted the idea of support for chaplains in health care. At that time, the Rev'd. Kirby Walsh, Anglican Chaplain, who functioned also as a Director of Pastoral Care at Western Memorial Hospital, along with the Rev'd. Gordon White at the Janeway Hospital in St. John's, Major Bramwell Foote at the Salvation Army Grace General Hospital in St. John's and Sister Carmelita Power of St. Clare's Mercy Hospital in St. John's got together to organize the Chaplain's Section.

**Second Name:** In **1983**, the **Chaplain's Section** was expanded to include community clergy, Clinical Pastoral Education students, Pastoral Care Associates and volunteers. The new name chosen was: **The Pastoral Care Section of the Newfoundland Hospital and Nursing Homes Association (NHNHA)**.

**Third Name:** Soon other disciplines recognized the importance of spiritual care in health and became members of the Pastoral Care Section. In **1994** the name was then changed to **The Pastoral Care Allied Health Group** of the Newfoundland and Labrador Health Boards Association (NLHBA).
